As usual, we were greeted that morning by the late Levi Dagenhart, who was the long-time face of the congregation, and now, whose memory we commemorate with the narthex stained-glass window panel.

Shortly after we joined, were invited by Ben & Kass Evans, also new retirees from "up north", to help in the food pantry. And after that, there was no down time. Jane taught Sunday school, I started with the choir with my great fellow tenor, Dennis Parlier. Over the years since, I have had multiple opportunities to share in the life of the congregation as a church council member for 15 + years during my service as Treasurer and later as Stewardship Chair. I also was a voting member of the NC Synod Assembly on multiple occasions

This congregation was of great support to us and our family, both during Jane's cancer treatment, her stay in Hospice and to me following her death. I will always treasure my days at Mt. Pisgah. It was a joy to worship with so many persons who became dear friends and that is what I will miss the most.

So, thank you to all of you who have journeyed along this path with me and to the many "Saints" of our congregation who have gone on before: (Christine Whitener, Larry Hollar, Dick Schmidt, Dennis Parlier, Sylvia Bevans, Ed Perry, Toni Burris, "Tut" Rector, Vonteena Bowman, Bill Bowman, Al Beck, Teresa Isenhour, Jewel Williams, and countless others) What a joy this journey has been! Special thanks, most recently, to the members and friends for your cards, calls, and visits during my hospital and rehab stays. You helped me heal!

Thanks, also, to Pastors: Ken (and Carol) Tonnesen; Jim (and Loretta) Stephenson; Mike (and Laura) Stone; and Tony Bradshaw, our spiritual leaders; and our lay leaders.

One final word from my stewardship days— "We are Church together" -- Mt. Pisgah congregation, the North Carolina Synod, and the church-wide, Evangelical Lutheran Church in America (ELCA). Our giving supports the work and service of all three expressions!

What began under a grape arbor in the 1830's as the Pisgah Camp Grounds, Mt. Pisgah now stands as a large and vibrant church in the NC Synod of the ELCA. May our Lord grant Mt. Pisgah, under the new leadership of Pastor Justin, many more years of witness and service to the Bethlehem/Hickory community.

Treasury Report for May/June 2025
4/21/2025

Thanks to the generosity of our congregation and the efficient management of resources by our staff, council and work teams are in a great position financially. After 9 months of this fiscal year our Income is \$333,971 which is 8% below budget. Expenses are \$307,284 which is 15% below budget as we have underspent in a number of areas. Our Reserve Fund balance was \$119,712 at the end of March which is up \$33,259 for the year.

As I write this note, we are working on the budget for our new year beginning in July. A copy, with notes, will be in your church mailboxes by the end of April and will be voted on at our Congregational meeting on May 19th. Our current year's budget is for Income and Expenses of \$483,000, while next year we will be around \$456,000. This is up slightly from what I project for our final figure for this year.

I have served in both Finance and Treasury roles for the past 6 years but have decided not to renew my term into next year. Through the years, I owe a lot to the mentorship of my friend, finance expert, and resident historian Bill Oelkers. I'm also thankful for the leadership of David Land as Council President. It has been a pleasure and an honor to serve with him.

We are financially healthy as God continues to provide all we need. We take care of ourselves and property, but most importantly we openly reach out to help those in need. Thank you for making that possible.


The coffee house Sunday school has collected a love offering that will be put in a gift card so they can purchase any final plants they feel they might want!

Coming This Summer: A New Study Based on *The Chosen* – Season 5


